GENRE: Narrative Nonfiction

- Facts about real people, places, or events are included.

 This information is shaped into a story.
- The real people become charaacters; the real places become settings; and the real events become the plot.
- Sometimes an author may add information about what a particular character is thinking or feeling even though the author could not really know this information.
- Blends elements of fiction with elements of nonfiction in order to make a story more exciting.
